Dr. Kriz is currently on medical staff at St. Charles Health System in Bend, Oregon. He also maintains a private practice, Neurobehavioral Health of Central Oregon and recently launched a childhood friendship making website, www.friendometry.com. In addition to his clinical responsibilities, he provides neuropsychological training at various levels. He serves as a liaison to pediatric neurology across the region as well as consults with various professionals within the Department of Education to improve educational needs for children with epilepsy as well as other neurological conditions.

Dr. Kriz provides neuropsychological assessment, treatment and consultation of the neurobehavioral effects of neurologic disorders, including epilepsy, brain tumors, cancer/cancer treatment, autism spectrum disorders, learning disabilities, ADHD, traumatic brain injury, genetic disorders, infectious diseases, non-epileptic seizures, and behavioral/emotional disorders.

Dr. Kriz completed his Doctoral degree in 2011 in Clinical Psychology from Pacific University.
