- Dr. Grodzinsky is currently Instructor in Psychology in the Department of Psychiatry, Harvard Medical School, and Associate Scientific Staff (Clinical) in the Neuropsychology Program, Department of Psychiatry, Children’s Hospital Boston, MA.
- She has an independent practice in Lexington, MA performing pediatric neuropsychological evaluations as well as providing school consultations and in-service workshops to professional groups. - Received her Ph.D. in 1990 from Boston College, Department of Counseling, Developmental Psychology and Research Methods.
