Biography:

Dr. Kaufman—an ex-national champion bicycle racer and ex-teammate of Lance Armstrong—became interested in the field of psychology after being exposed to sport psychology while attending training camps at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs, CO. He earned his B.A. from the University of New Mexico in 1998, his master’s degree from the University of Oregon in 2001, and his Ph.D. from the University of Oregon in 2003. He completed an APA-approved pre-doctoral internship at the University of New Mexico Health Sciences Center, a 1-year post-doctoral program at Mesilla Valley Hospital in Las Cruces, NM, and a 2-year post-doctoral program in clinical neuropsychology through the Fielding Graduate University under the guidance of Dr. Arnold Purisch.
